Overall results were Phil, Qld State Champion with a score of 5 points, Larry Kleist on 11 points and John Warlow on 16 points.

Presentation was on the lawn with prizes supplied by Torquay Pharmacy and the beautifully restored perpetual trophy presented to Phil. A big thanks and our gratitude to Stu Bishop, CEO Wallace Bishop Jewellers for the great work in bringing the trophy back to it's pristine original condition. It will be displayed proudly in the new glass display cabinets along with the Australian trophy at RQYS.
